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the success and survival of american democracy have never been guaranteed arguing that we must take an unflinching look at the nature of democracy and therefore ourselves
historian robert tracy mckenzie explores the ideas of human nature in the history of american democratic thought from the nation s founders through the jacksonian era and alexis de toqueville

as of 2012 only 43 men have held the office of the president of the united states some have been sanctified and some reviled this historical work addresses the careers of the first ten presidents men who made vital contributions not only to the office of the presidency but to the course of the fledgling nation from washington through tyler every term is recounted in

detail and each presidential profile provides as many as a hundred quotations with full source notes by the president his friends family historians and others each profile ends with an extensive bibliography of books about the president his principles and policies and also provides suggestion for further reading rigorously nonpartisan in approach this detail rich text describes the early years of what may well be one of the most demanding jobs in the world

in 1871 the young mineralogist albert peale set out with the vaunted hayden expedition to map and explore the yellowstone basin ferdinand hayden asked peale his former student to write a series of letters to the philadelphia press about the survey s work just as these letters the first impressions of yellowstone sent back from the field introduced nineteenth century readers to some of the most breathtaking wonders of the american west they allow readers today to rediscover one of the nation s most beloved and visited natural areas as it was just five months before it became the world s first national park ø written by a scientist for the general reader peale s letters convey the grandeur of yellowstone with great clarity and immediacy even as they offer apt detailed descriptions of the basin s geologic features from the geysers giant grotto and mud among others to the creeks and rivers craters and springs illustrating these descriptions are the earliest artistic images of yellowstone also done during the expedition watercolor field sketches by thomas moran photographs by william henry jackson and the now little known works of the party s official artist henry wood elliott ranging from dramatic panoramic landscapes to lighthearted sketches of the expedition s more personal moments these images combine with peale s written impressions to give readers a true and rare sense of what it was like for these men to marvel at yellowstone for the first time

there s just no way around it this life is full of tough choices some people seem to glide calmly through life others seem to have been given a raw deal their life is filled with bumps and bruises either way life is a journey with many choices to make and many paths from which to choose jackson s journey is about one such life at the tender age of thirteen jackson s world is turned upside down and his family is torn away he is thrust out into a world and must decide what choices to make and paths to choose

what makes a leader truly great is it simply a matter of management style and personality or is it character that matters most moral visions takes an insightful look into america s leaders of the past to answer these questions and demonstrates that values and moral convictions are critical to the strength of a nation supposedly we learn about the candidates for the highest office through a series of tests called debates which are instead an exchange of soundbites we can t know whether an aspirant to the presidency has the ability to ask good questions or only a suave or belligerent ability to answer them moral vision is a human interest introduction to american history through studies of nineteen leaders presidents almost presidents a tycoon a crusading journalist and even a leading 19th century abortionist its lessons can help voters sort through the candidates in 2024 and beyond by measuring them against previous leaders none of whom was faultless it shows how the deepest views often grow out of religious belief and influence political goals racial prejudices sexual activities uses of power and senses of service in his 1789 inaugural address george washington pledged that the foundation for national policy will be laid in the sure and immutable principles of private morality marvin olasky shows how 19th century leaders like thomas jefferson andrew jackson and grover cleveland partly upheld and partly ignored that promise and 20th century leaders like woodrow wilson john f kennedy and bill clinton tried to compartmentalize the private and the public an extensively updated version of the american leadership tradition moral vision is for anyone tired of today s textbook tendencies to submerge the role of individuals as big economic and demographic waves roll in history is more than statistics economics and group identities human beings are more than paper boats riding the rainfall into gutters

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
